

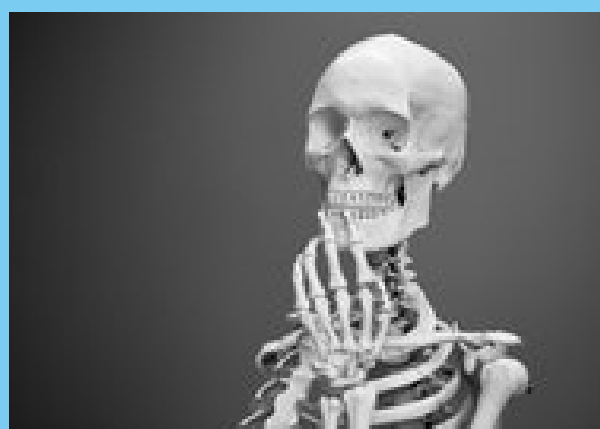

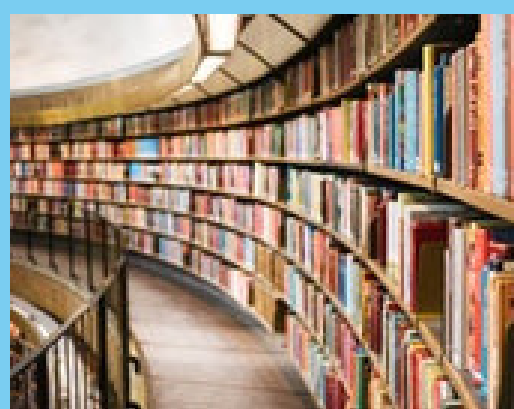

Do you like to read?

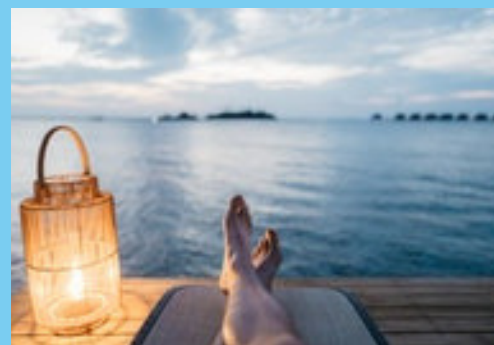


¿Te gusta dormir?
